## **ABOUT AMERICAN LAND CONSERVANCY**

Founded in 1990, the American Land Conservancy (ALC) is a private, nonprofit organization dedicated to the preservation of land and water as enduring resources, and to the protection and enhancement of our nation's natural, ecological, historical, recreational, agricultural, and scenic heritage. ALC seeks to preserve the diversity of native plant, wildlife and aquatic communities, to guard and restore the natural integrity of ecosystems, and to expand opportunities to public recreation and education.

## **OBJECTIVES**

ALC was formed as a national land trust specializing in complex and difficult land transactions. Our strategy is to work cooperatively with willing landowners, ranchers, and farmers, to option environmentally sensitive land, arrange appraisals, surveys, and all other pre-sale requirements, and then execute the purchase of the land interests for the protection of the resources forever. Our low overhead and small, dedicated staff permits us to move quickly to pursue conservation opportunities. By utilizing a wide array of traditional and innovative real estate techniques, including direct purchases, land exchanges and conservation easements, ALC is able to protect crucial properties.

## **ALC CONSERVATION PROGRAMS**

- ∞ Protection of rivers, riparian corridors and water rights
- ∞ Preservation of endangered species and wildlife habitat
- ∞ Acquisition of recreational lands for public use/access
- ∞ Consolidation of wilderness and roadless areas
- ∞ Restoration of wetlands areas
- ∞ Preservation of prime agricultural lands
- ∞ Preservation of forests

## **SUCCESS**

ALC has conveyed into the public trust more than 137,000 acres with a fair market value of more than \$355,000,000. Some of these conservation projects are now included in new and existing public parks, forests, wildlife refuges, river-ways, and greenbelts, across the United States; others are subject to privately held conservation easements, which ensure the protection of their ecological and agricultural resources forever.
